## **Description of Vehicle:**

This is a 2017 Ford Mustang Tickford Bathurst 77 Commemorative Edition car and is number 6 of 77 built.

We have viewed this vehicle and arrived at a value specifically for insurance purposes as requested by the owner.

This vehicle was purchased by the current owner from Australia as a damaged vehicle and has since undergone a full restoration process by the Mustang specialists at Matamata Panelworks/Shelby NZ. The car has now been returned to a flawless standard and is in immaculate as new condition.

The Tickford Bathurst '77 Special, is a high performance, limited edition Tickford Mustang GT that pays homage to the Ford Falcon XC Hardtops that Allan Moffat and team-mate Colin Bond drove in the famous 1-2 win at the 1977 Bathurst 1000.

Only 77 models of the Tickford Bathurst 77 Special were built, with most residing in private Australian collections. We are pretty sure this is the only one in NZ.

Modelled off the livery of the Ford Falcon XC Hardtops, the Tickford Bathurst '77 Special features a range of unique components, engineered to provide a special and individual driving experience.

In true Tickford style the Mustang GT's 5.0-litre power plant is fitted with a high-performance supercharger, significantly increasing the Ford V8's power and torque, with the vehicle putting out in excess of 727 Hp (542 Kw) and 827 Nm of torque.

Externally, the car reflects the 1977 version of the Falcon with a modern interpretation of the livery. All 77 cars are fitted with a full decal kit, including race number 1 on the doors and roof. A replica style XC Falcon coupe rear wing is fitted along with a Moffat signature numbered build plate finish to finish of the package.

The interior of the car is all custom with leather, alcantara and red and blue stitching throughout. The car also has a special steering wheel and shift knob along with Tickford badging throughout.

This car is also 1 of only 6 automatics out of the 77 built.

- Rear Wilwood high performance, racing red, 4-piston calliper, with 14" slotted rotors and separate parking brake assembly, supported by high performance brake pads

• Full replacement leather trim, front and rear, featuring a unique and modern interpretation of the exterior of the XC Coupe with a leather and alcantara base, along with red and blue stitching, and embroidered Tickford wings in the seat back (Additional padding in the driver's seat for comfort and support)

- Upgraded centre console in leather and alcantara, featuring red and blue stitching and the Tickford logo
- Uprated steering wheel, again featuring red and blue stitching, and a leather and alcantara trim while having been enhanced in thickness for better tactile feel
- Ford Performance XC Falcon retro-inspired gear knob
- Interior Tickford badging including a build plate number on the dashboard

#### Aesthetics

- Tickford Bonnet struts
- Retro-inspired rear spoiler, painted black
- The bonnet, boot lid and wing mirror caps all painted black to mirror the 1977 Ford XC Coupe
- External badging includes replacing the 5.0 side badges with chrome Bathurst 77 Special logo, a replacement front grille Mustang emblem in black, Tickford front grille badge and unique Tickford wings logo featuring the red and blue of the car at the rear
- A modern interpretation of the 1977 XC Coupe, featuring a complete decal set matched to the Mustang's exterior, including a Number 1 fitted to the bonnet, roof and doors
